End of Year Reward Trips 2024


We would like to take this opportunity to inform you of the plans for the end of term reward trips for all students who have achieved 1500 positive points.

Since its launch last February our reward and recognition system has been very successful and students strive each day to achieve positive points in their lessons. The purpose of our reward system is to give students recognition for their efforts throughout the year which will then make them feel valued, help to build their confidence and give them motivation to achieve. The system is aligned to our whole school values of 'We Care, We Aim High, We Learn and Achieve Together'. In addition, rewarding good behaviour enables students to become self-disciplined, take responsibility for themselves and work together as a community.

We are following on from the successful events we held last year at Woodmill activity centre and will be offering activities such as Donutting, paddle boarding and an inflatable swimming session. There will also be an alternative opportunity to take part in a theatre trip. These events will take place from Monday 8 July through to Friday 19 July.

The deadline for students to achieve 1500 positive points will be Friday 7 June, this is due to having to confirm numbers for the events in advance. If your child has successfully achieved 1500 positive points by this date they will receive a letter with instructions on how to select the activity they wish to participate in. The costs of these activities will range from £10 to £17 and we will be asking for contributions to secure your child's place.
